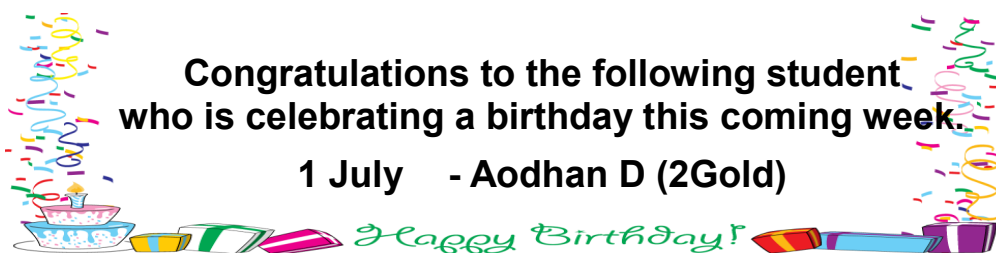
Year 3 Dads' Night Out, Friday 23rd June, Blue Gum Hotel, 7.30pm
