Teachers in Years 3 and 5 will be talking to the students about this in the next few days.

This testing is in preparation for the possibility of next year's

Naplan switching to an online environment. NESA are conducting Naplan readiness testing across all New South Wales Schools during Term 3. These tests are for administrative purposes only and designed to test the capacity of our schools online environments, devices and NESA Systems. These tests will not be marked and do not contribute to NAPLAN testing already completed this year and for which results have been sent home.


