Refurbishment around the school

Over the Christmas break we had quite a lot of refurbishment done around the school.

All Kinder, Year 1, Year 2, Year 5 and Year 6 classrooms were painted, the Kindergarten toilet was renovated and new tiles in the disabled toilet. Carpet was laid in the music/art space as it was transformed into a 5/6 classroom. My thanks to Mrs Ward who managed all these processes.

Additionally, through a grant available through OOSH, we have resurfaced the half court and added artificial grass right to the edge of the court.




