Role of a Class Parent

- Organise social events; for example, mums coffee mornings, family plays in the park in the holidays, dinners for mums and/or dads.
- Play a key role in communication on the year group Facebook page. Informing parents of upcoming school and social events, reminders and answering questions parents may have, especially in the Kindergarten group.
- Get to know your fellow parents and act as a liaison between parents and teacher. Introduce yourself to your teacher.
- Keep parents informed of happenings within the school.
- Encourage parents to volunteer for events where the school requires parental support; such as our annual Open Day, Grandparents' Day, swimming/sports carnivals, Family Fair, Mother's Day stall, and other whole school activities.
- Encourage parents to let you know if they hear of people who need support; for example, a new baby, family bereavement or other family crisis where support and meals may be needed.
- Organise end-of-year gift for teacher(s) if you want to.
- Ideally one Class Parent from each grade to attend P&F Meetings.
